By the end of 2019, St Pius achievement in literacy will be aligned with the BCE system targets through the embedding of effective and expected practices and effective use of feedback for all stakeholders.

By the end of 2019, staff will have a greater understanding of the BCE strategy for Mathematics (NuMa), gathered data on student understanding and progress in Numeracy and implemented targeted teaching approaches in response to this data.

By the end of 2019, St Pius school will have 95% of students in attendance 90% of the time to enhance student engagement and results.
